ITINERARY AUGUST 27 – SEPTEMBER 5, 2025

Depart U.S. on group flight to Rome

DAY 2 **AUGUST 28**

Arrive in Rome and transfer to Assisi. Celebrate Mass at Santa Maria degli Angeli, where Francis started the Franciscan Order

DAY 3 AUGUST 29

Visit La Verna, where Francis received the Stigmata. After Mass, hike the first leg of the Via di Francesco through Casentinesi Forests National Park. (15 km hike)

DAY 4 AUGUST 30

Celebrate Mass in Gubbio, where Francis first put on what would become the Franciscan habit and where he famously tamed a wolf. Hike up to the Abbey of San'Ubaldo and the fortress of Mount Ignino. (20 km hike)

DAY 5

Begin with Mass in Terni, then hike down to AUGUST 31 Greccio, where Francis created the first nativity scene in 1223. (20 km hike)

DAY 6

SEPTEMBER 1

Mass in the Basilica of St. Francis in Assisi, where the saint is buried. Free time to explore the city.

DAY 7

SEPTEMBER 2

Depart for Rome to experience the ancient Church with Mass and tour at the Basilica of San Clemente and its excavations, plus an afternoon visit to the Colosseum.

DAY 8

SEPTEMBER 3

Mass at St. Peter's Basilica, followed by a tour. Afternoon visits to the Basilica of Santa Croce, the Holy Stairs, and St. John Lateran.

DAY 9

SEPTEMBER 4

Morning entrance to the Vatican museums. An afternoon city center walking tour to explore the piazzas and churhces of Rome. Closing Mass followed by a farewell dinner.

Depart for the U.S.
